Bitwarden / LastPass (Free & Paid)

- Password managers to store credentials securely.

- Enable waiting rooms and authentication to enhance privacy.

- Check for FERPA and COPPA compliance on all education facing apps.
- Train staff and students on how to use tools safely and effectively.
- Centralize logins and access through your school's existing identity system.
